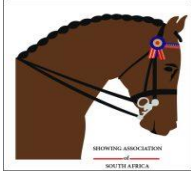

GENERAL	1. All classes are run under SASA Rules -24th Edition (1 January 2024)
	2. All riders and horses must be registered with a Club, SAEF & SASA. Membership forms are available at www.showingsa.co.za or from admin@showingsa.co.za . Temporary SASA membership will not be allowed for graded classes at this show.
	3. SASA will pay entry fees for all classes for SASA EDTS competitors, this includes In Hand and Under Saddle classes. The competitor must be a SASA EDTS member. This membership is free. Applications forms are available on the SASA website or admin@showingsa.co.za . EDTS will earn EDTS Victor Ludorum points.
	4. Competitors in the Working Hunter classes will be required to jump 8 to 12 fences, this includes one combination.
	5. Should a rider qualify with more than one horse for the Championship, they may nominate another fully paid up SASA member to show their 2nd horse in the Championship. The individual test must be completed by the competitor.
	6. By entering this show Competitors indemnify any judge , registered with SASA, officiating at this show, against any and all claims of any nature from any cause whatsoever.
	7.Registered SASA Instructors will earn Victor Ludorum points for pupils
	8. Adult Open horses will be ridden by the judge/s
	9.Horse heights must reflect in the horse's passport.
	10. The minimum age for horses under saddle is 3 years of age.
	11. 59.2.1 All competitors, owners and sponsors shall be registered with a club, in whose area of jurisdiction they have their principal place of residence, SAEF and SASA and shall be re-registered on 1 January of each year. Membership forms are available on the SASA website or from admin@showingsa.co.za or mangoldjacquie@gmail.com or percoffice@gmail.com
	12.Horse must be registered with SAEF and SASA.
	13. Competitors may only ride one horse in each class, with the exception of Working classes where they may ride up to three horses.
	14.The horse rider combination will compete as member of the Province where the horse rider combination is resident.
	15.On no account , and under the penalty of disqualification, may any horse be ridden by anyone other that the competing rider of that horse or the judge from the first day of the show until the end of the last competitive class in which the horse is competing. (Excluding all grooms ridden classes for which SASA has given special dispensation)
Objections and Appeals	As per SASA General Regulations 2022, all objections and appeals must be lodged with the Technical Delegate in writing within 30mins from the completion of the class and accompanied by the required deposit of R750.
Passports	All competitors must have their up-to-date horse passports at the event for inspection at any time. Horses whose passports do not fully comply with the current Government and SASA regulations may be refused permission to compete and asked to leave the venue.
Testing and Checking	Both horses and athletes may be tested by SAEF officials at any time during the show for prohibited substances.
Conduct and Yellow Cards	Any owner or rider who attempts to interfere with or influence judges, officials, and stewards, or who at any time on the show grounds uses any contemptuous or abusive language to any of the judges, officials or stewards will forfeit his/her rights to any prizes to which they might otherwise be entitled and will receive a yellow card which will require them to remove themselves and their horse from the grounds pending a disciplinary enquiry.
Indemnity	All persons participating at this event do so at their own risk and will have no claim against PE Riding Club, South African Equestrian Federation (SAEF), SASA (Showing Association of South Africa including any officials, employees, members, affiliated bodies, show-holding bodies or sponsors of PE Riding Club, SASA or SAEF, for any damage or loss of property or death or injury of persons suffered during or in connection with this event from any cause whatsoever. No minor may participate in this event without the permission of his/her guardian, who indemnifies PE Riding Club, SASA and SAEF (including all other persons and bodies) against any such claims by such minors.

No cross entry of horse and rider combination in the SA Inter-Provincial Team and the Challenge Team, but a rider may compete in both teams on two different horses. Horses may not compete in both Teams with different Riders. Horses will not be ridden by the Judge in the Challenge Team Event. Grooms challenge teams can be made of riders from any province.

Awards:	Medals & Rosettes will be awarded to all team members.

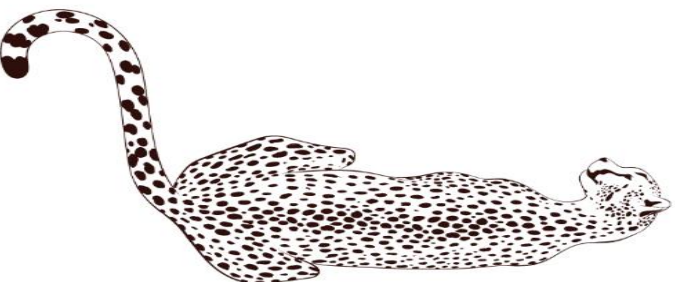

Competitors wishing to be stabled with others should put on their entry form and the organizing committee will try to arrange this, however there is no guarantee. With that said, all **Provincial horses will be stabled together**. Initial bedding will be provided. Additional bedding will be available for the duration of the show at your own cost.



PE RIDING CLUB GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS APPLICABLE TO ALL DISCIPLINES

(Discipline specific Rules and Regulations are detailed separately per discipline in this schedule)



1. Payments are due on the closing date. Proof of payment must be emailed to percoffice@gmail.com and mangoldjacquie@gmail.com by entry closing date , failing which the entry will not be processed.
2. No horse may enter the show without a horse flu vaccination and AHS, please complete details (date & batch number) on entry form.
3. No refunds/credits will be made in respect of cancellations and scratchings after closing date of entries.
4. Insofar as possible, the program and conditions relating thereto will be adhered to. However, the Organizing Committee reserves the right to make alterations in the event of unfavourable weather conditions or any other unforeseen circumstances. The Organizing Committee further reserves the right to combine, vary, divide or cancel classes if insufficient entries are received. Depending on entries classes may be combined and/or handicapped and separate prizes will not be awarded. The show holding body of the PERC reserves the right to limit entries, depending on the total number of entries received per class.
5. Should the show be cancelled for any reason only 50% of entry fees will be refunded. No entries will be refunded if the show is postponed.
6. The SAEF, SASA and the Port Elizabeth Riding Club , including their staff , organizers , committee members and all officials appointed by them , shall in no way be held responsible for any damage, loss or injury sustained to or by owners, competitors, grooms, horses , members of the public or any other person or persons or their property at the PE Riding Club for the duration of show. By entering this show you hereby indemnify them from any and all claims in connection with your participation in the show.
7. Competition arenas out of bound unless in competition
8. All horses / ponies that are prone to kicking must wear a red ribbon on their tails when not competing in a class.
9. No cooking fires are allowed anywhere on the premises at any time.
10. By entering a stallion at the PERC, the competitor & owner agree to the following :
 - 10.1. Competition stallions remain the responsibility of the owner and rider at all times and are expected to have public liability against any loss, injury or damage that might be caused by the stallion.
 - 10.2. It is the responsibility of the owner & rider to ensure that the stallion cannot exit the stable allocated to it on its own/or with the help of another horse or uninformed person.
 - 10.3. The stallion may only be removed from the stable during the show for exercise, preparation or competition & only by a responsible handler or rider.
 - 10.4. Under NO circumstances shall the covering of mares be allowed to take place at the PERC premises.
 - 10.5. All stallions must wear a yellow tag on their bridles at all times and will be handled and ridden by persons over the age of 18 yrs.
11. PERC ground staff will close all perimeter gates as well as the gates of the stable block at the end of each show day. PERC will not accept responsibility nor liability for any gates that are thereafter left opened by riders or any other person , specifically grooms that are sleeping in horseboxes on the premises overnight.
12. It is the responsibility of all competitors to ensure they and their horses are correctly registered with all National and Provincial bodies. All FEI and SAEF rules shall apply.
13. No Temporary Paddocks permitted

 - ⤵ Take exit 740 for M7 toward Lorraine 450m.
2. Continue on Samantha Way/M7. Take Kragga Kamma Rd/M15, Circular Dr and Bergeus St to Mirecourt Ave in Lorraine Manor 5.8km:
 - ⤵ Turn right onto Samantha Way/M7 1.4km.
 - ⤵ Turn right toward Kragga Kamma Rd/M15 30m.
 - ⤴ Slight right onto Kragga Kamma Rd/M15 700m.
 - ⤵ Turn left onto Circular Dr (go through 1 roundabout) 1.6km.
 - ⤴ Continue straight to stay on Circular Dr 650m.
 - ⤵ Turn right onto Van Eck St 350m.
 - ⤴ At the roundabout, take the 1st exit 19m.
 - ⤴ Continue onto Van Eck St 170m.
 - ⤴ Continue onto Bergeus St 800m.

From East London side to PERC:

1. Follow N2 to Cape Rd/R102 in Sunridge Park, Gqeberha. Take exit 742 from N2 198km:
 - ⤵ Turn left onto N2 67km.
 - ⤴ Continue straight to stay on N2 76km.
 - ⤴ N2 turns slightly left and becomes N2 54.2km.
 - ⤵ Take exit 742 for R102/Cape Road toward Kragga Kamma Road/M15/Port Elizabeth 400m.
2. Take Kragga Kamma Rd/M15, Circular Dr and Bergeus St to Mirecourt Ave in Lorraine Manor 6.2km:
 - ⤴ Use the left lane to merge onto Cape Rd/R102 130m.
 - ⤵ Use the left 2 lanes to take the M15/Kragga Kamma Road exit 350m.
 - ⤴ Continue onto Kragga Kamma Rd/M15 2km.
 - ⤵ Turn left onto Circular Dr (go through 1 roundabout) 1.6km.
